Project Description: Moore & Bruggink, Inc., provided design and construction engineering for this \$1.5 million street and utility reconstruction project. The projects were completed in three phases over a three year period. The project included analysis and design of a new storm sewer system which discharged into two county drains. Design elements also included new signalized railroad crossing. The street was widened to include a center turn lane, several retaining walls were incorporated into the design to minimize effects on surrounding properties. The street was designed utilizing asphalt and concrete pavements. Concrete pavement was necessary to accommodate heavy truck traffic to the dock area and also to two regional oil/gas terminals. The street elevations were designed to match an existing bike path and to promote drainage into the new storm sewer.
