Project Description:



Reconstruct 4,000 feet of West Main Avenue from Washington Avenue to State Street and also 1,500 feet of Pine Street from Central Avenue to West Main Avenue. The project included complete reconstruction of all underground utilities, new sidewalks, relocation of aerial utilities underground, and correction of drainage conditions. The project was completed on time and under budget as a two-phase project. Phase II was constructed as a local agency project with Federal funds administered by MDOT, design and construction engineering of 1/2 of a mile of which included replacing sanitary sewer, storm sewer and watermain. New curb and gutter, sidewalks, drives, pavement, street lights and street trees were included with the project.
